

Bracelet Sizing Guidelines

IMPORTANT:

To correctly print the ruler, make sure your print options are set to print the page at 100% normal size.

Be sure “Fit to Page” is turned **Off** or **None** on your printer setup.

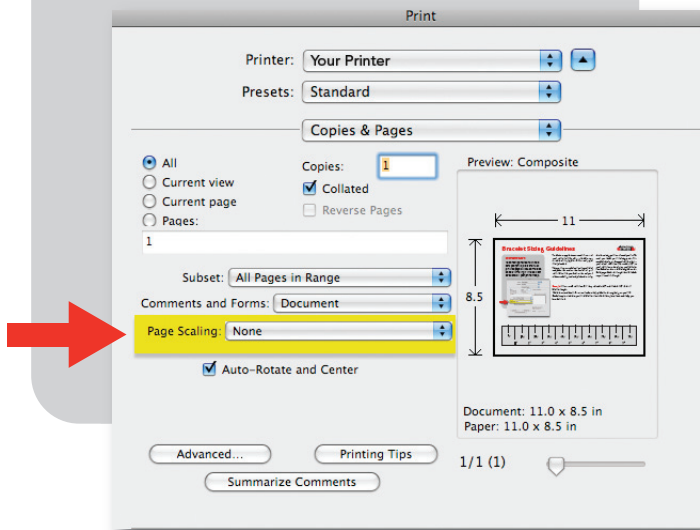
To obtain an approximate measurement of your wrist, start by using a flexible tape measure, piece of string or simply print and cut our paper ruler provided.

Take your tape measure or our paper ruler, and place the end on the center of your wrist. Make sure you start at the very end of the measuring tool and proceed to wrap

the remaining portion around your wrist until you reach your starting point. The number where you stopped will determine your actual wrist size. Now add a 1/2” to your wrist size to determine your bracelet size. Based on the available lengths on the Build Page, select the length that is closest to your measured length.

Example: If someone’s wrist size is 6” they will add a 1/2” and select 6 1/2” as their bracelet length.

We recommend the fit is not too loose to help preserve the engraving on your ID. Please keep in mind that your final bracelet size includes the plate, chain and clasp you have selected.
